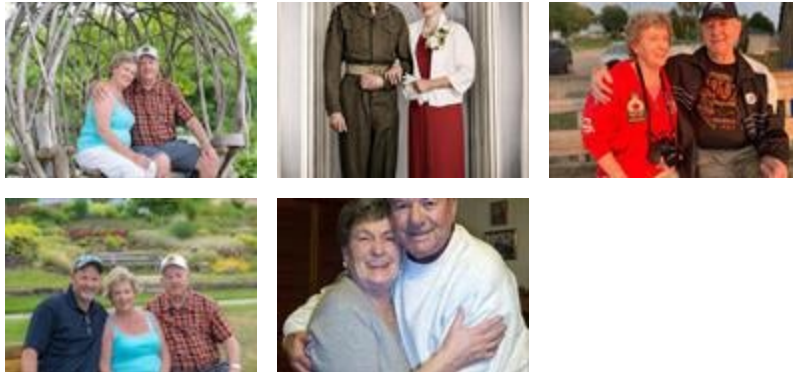


“ *My Mum - In gentle whispers, soft and true,
