After a courageous battle with kidney cancer, Clayton died peacefully at home on March 11, 2018 in the loving arms of close family members.

His journey was marked with a fervent desire to advance the use of personalized and combination cancer treatment strategies under the incomparable care of Dr. Georg Bjarnason and his superb nursing team at Odette Cancer Centre of Sunnybrook Hospital.

The family also wishes to acknowledge the dedicated and compassionate care Clayton received by the palliative care teams at Sunnybrook Hospital and Temmy Latner Centre.

In accordance with Clayton's wishes, there will be no funeral service.

However, family and friends are encouraged to enjoy an activity that reminds you of Clayton. Whether that is going for a run on a Sunday morning, heading out for a round of golf on a sunny afternoon, taking a drive to 7-11 for a slurpee run, grabbing chicken wings and a pint at your local pub, going for a walk through the park, fishing at your cottage, heading to a hockey or baseball game to cheer on the Maple Leafs or Blue Jays, or just grabbing a coffee at Starbucks with friends, please do it with Clayton in mind.
