



## Mr. Duc Huu Huynh

November 9, 2015

Duc Huynh, beloved father of four girls survived by his lifelong friend, and dearest wife, Anh, passed away at aged 67 on November 9, 2015 at the Credit Valley Hospital in Mississauga, Canada from complications related to Hepatitis C; a chronic liver disease inherited from a contaminated blood transfusion in his early twenties. Surrounded by his loving family, he passed away peacefully in the night.

His unending love and dedication to his family and work was felt by all of those whom he touched.

Born and raised in Rach Gia, Vietnam on September 25, 1948, he was the eldest of 12 children. His commitment and strong work ethics was a demonstration of his sturdy character and noble heart. He became Captain of the police regiment in his early twenties, and married his loving wife, Anh in 1972.

The Vietnamese war tore the family apart as he escaped from the persecutions of the Viet Cong during this treacherous time. Fleeing for his life, and forced to leave his family behind, he was shipwrecked in Malaysia along with some of his siblings. Sponsored by a generous Christian family in Mississauga, ON, he was able to start a new life in a free country. During his first year in Canada, he prepared to bring his family over from a Thailand refugee camp where they also escaped from the torments of the civil war. Finally successful in 1980, the family was reunited again, and their new life began.

Duc's strong spirit, silly sense of humour and a love for his family, friends and co-workers is expressed in his 43 years of marriage, and longtime employment in the hospitality industry for 39 years in Canada. Although there were many hardships of being a new immigrant to a new country, he never failed to provide for his family, and applied his strong Buddhist beliefs of compassion, love and generosity.

His memory continues to live on in his four girls: Phuong, Ishtar, Katherine, and Kim, three grandchildren: Isis, Lihana, and Sananda, brothers and sisters, and the many friends he has made along the way.

His new journey now begins in another form and place, applying all that he has learned in his lifetime.
