Edmond (“Ed”) Chu, formerly of Niagara Falls, Ontario, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, March 8, 2016, at the age of 77, after a brief illness. Ed is survived by his long time partner, Angie Chu of Niagara Falls, his daughters, Gina Chu (Anthony Feher) of Toronto, Louanna Chu of Thornhill and Edna Chu (Scott Simmons) of Toronto, and his grandchildren, Emma and Alex Feher, Ella and Chloe Ritco, Haley Chu and Declan and Abbey Simmons. He is also remembered by relatives and friends in and around the Niagara Region, Toronto, and Taishan, China. Ed arrived in Canada as a teenager in the early 1950s. He is best remembered as the owner of Chu’s Restaurant & Tavern on Centre St. in Niagara Falls, Ontario, for almost 25 years and, then, Chu’s Dining Lounge in Niagara Falls, New York, for the next 15 years until he retired in 2008. Leading up to and during his retirement, Ed made numerous trips back to his birthplace in Taishan, Guangdong Province, China, for extended periods until he had a stroke in 2012. He then returned to Canada and settled at The Heritage Nursing Home in Leslieville, Toronto, until his death.
