Ted Reeves, beloved husband, father and grandfather from Scarborough, Ontario, passed away suddenly at the age of 83 on August 26th, 2017 at Toronto Western Hospital, following complications resulting from surgery to repair a broken hip.

Born in Gravenhurst, Ontario, Ted moved to Toronto where he met, married and is survived by his wife of sixty-one years Florence Anne (Robson).

Ted was born January 31, 1934 in Gravenhurst, Ontario to Ernest and Mary Catherine "Kay" (Tunney) Reeves. Ted was loved and will be dearly missed by his wife Anne, his five children; Robert, Richard (Cara), Christine, James (Eva), Thomas, his eleven grandchildren; Ashley, Candace, Connor, Evann, Grayson, Jessica, Lauren, Liam, Melissa, Michelle and Rebecca, his brother Bob, sister Betty Anne and many friends.

Ted was employed by IBM Canada for over 35 years and enjoyed a lengthy career that saw him consistently promoted and working out of IBM Offices across Canada, including Edmonton, Winnipeg and Vancouver, before returning to Toronto in 1968. After retiring from IBM, Ted was part of a Team that introduced and installed high tech computer systems in High Schools in Ontario. Ted was passionate about the idea of replacing some traditional shop classes with emerging technologies to introduce children to an exciting future. Ted volunteered his time as a Director on the Board for LakeRidge Health System for four years and was a PM Consultant for the renovations at

Centenary Hospital.

In his spare time, Ted was an avid racquetball player and golfer. He participated annually for over 25 years with friends at the Bogey Beach Invitational Golf Tournament near Goderich, Ontario. In his retirement years he also enjoyed reading, gardening and spending time with his children and grandchildren.

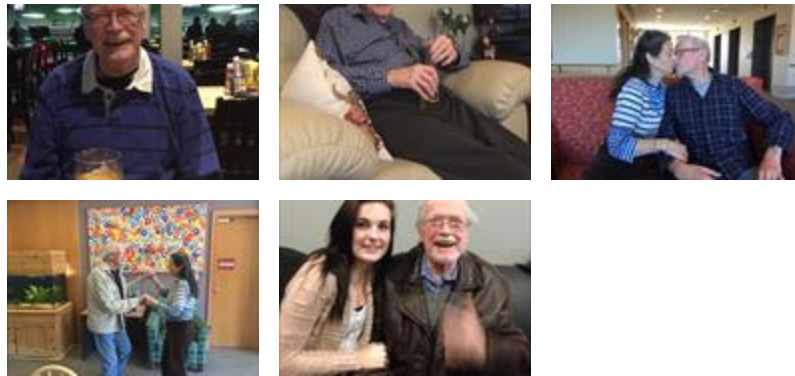
