“ I remember befriending Jean's son Murray; back in the early 70's; in Chelmsford, Ontario. They moved to another community (Val Caron) not far away a couple of years later. With things not going too well at home and my grades in school on a downward slide in Grade 11 - I began making my way to the Luck's house in that neighboring community usually by Thursday or Friday - attended as many classes with Murray as the teachers would allow and then spend the weekends with the Luck family. I was welcomed by older brother Mike, Christine, Myles and Martin and put up with by their father Bruce. Jean always made me feel welcome and at home during those trying times in my life. She was always there for me as I dealt with family issues. When I was 16 years of age - I told my mother I was about to purchase a car (to make getting to the Luck's easier). Her response was - if you do - "I'll have your belongings packed and in the driveway upon your return. I have no idea where you are as it is - at least now I know your in Chelmsford most of the time. With a car I'll worry sick" I told her to start packing - I'll be home with the car in about an hour.

With my car loaded down with my cloths and a few belongings I arrived at the Luck's residence - to show off my new wheels. When Jean came home from work at Reitman's (I believe) I was anxious to show her my car - she was the only one that said anything about my belongings being in the vehicle.

She took me aside and asked; what was going on. I explained what had happened at home. She gently explained how difficult it must be from a mother's perspective and assured me - as usual - everything was going to be alright and that in the meantime - as long as I stayed in school - I was always welcome to hang my hat there; until matters got better at home.

I took half my Grade 11 courses that I failed the year before and all of my Grade 12 courses that coming school year and graduated (along with her son Murray) that year of 1975.

Mostly because of Jean's non-judgemental attitude and a motherly need to welcome other's; less fortunate; into her loving arms and into her unselfish heart. I think of you from time to time and realize how fortunate I was to have your motherly charm in my life; when I

so desperately needed it.

Thanks Jean - there's a piece of you in me; as I travel this road of life. You taught me plenty about unconditional love, unselfishness and forgiveness.

Tell Bruce to come over here; so I can piss on him - so that - at least he'll smell like a man." Tee Hee. And give the old fart a big hug for me. I miss him too.
