Elizabeth (Liesje, Louise) Gosschalk, 95, of Brampton, Ontario, passed away on May 29, 2023 at Holland Christian Homes, Brampton.

Louise was born at 5 o'clock, June 25, 1927 in Velp (Arnhem), Holland to Maria (nee: Willemsen) and Geurt Jalink. Her identical twin, Maria (deceased), was born at 5:30. Louise and her parents followed Maria to Canada directly after WWII, as Maria was a war bride to a Canadian Soldier. The family established itself in the GTA. Both sisters survived life threatening accidents very early on, and through Louise's tragedy, she was introduced to a young dutchman who became her husband, Bob Gosschalk (deceased). Louise is survived by and will be dearly missed by two daughters, Margaret Young and Ingrid Mueller (Roland), four grandchildren, Jeffrey Young (Katherine), Torsten Mueller (Kendra), Tyson Mueller (Becca) and Mercedes Mueller, 5 great-grandchildren, Rowan, Logan and Isla Young, Charlotte Mueller, and one nephew, Terrance Geissler (Cristina, Nicolas, Lucas and Sofia).

Louise believed strongly in giving back to her community. She was a long time volunteer at the Toronto Orthopaedic Hospital and was officially recognized by the Mayor of Toronto for over 30 years of dedicated service. Louise may not have been a swimmer, but she was surely an avid boater. Louise, Bob and their dogs spent many summer vacations cruising Lake Simcoe and the Trent Waterway to Georgian Bay. Oh, the dogs! They went everywhere together. It is difficult to remember Louise without a little 'hondje' on her lap.
