In retirement she contributed to her community through various other volunteer roles touching the lives of many through her kindness.

Ethelwyn was the confident of many, and made everyone feel welcome. She encouraged everyone to live their best lives and was grateful for the full life she lived.

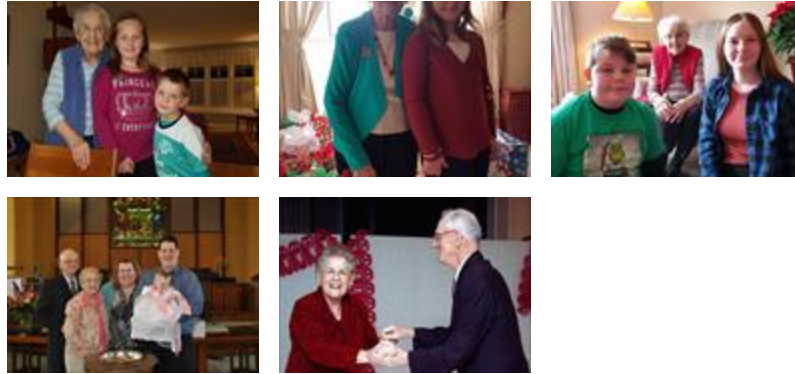
The family are grateful to all those who cared for her in Brantford and at Lakeview Manor in Beaverton.

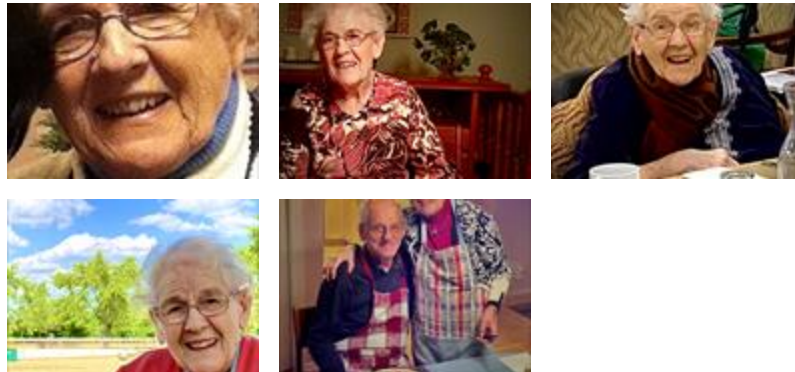
