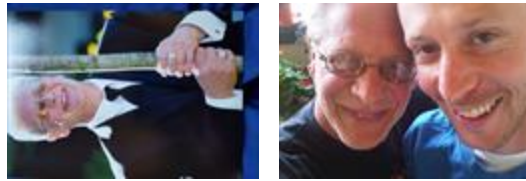

THEN I KNEW THAT SOMETHING DID NOT GO AS PREDICTED. SO I RUSHED TO TORONTO GENERAL HOSPITAL. AND I TALKED TO YOU FROM A SMALL DISTANCE. BUT YOU COULD NOT OPEN YOUR EYES. MAYBE YOU COULD HEAR ME. 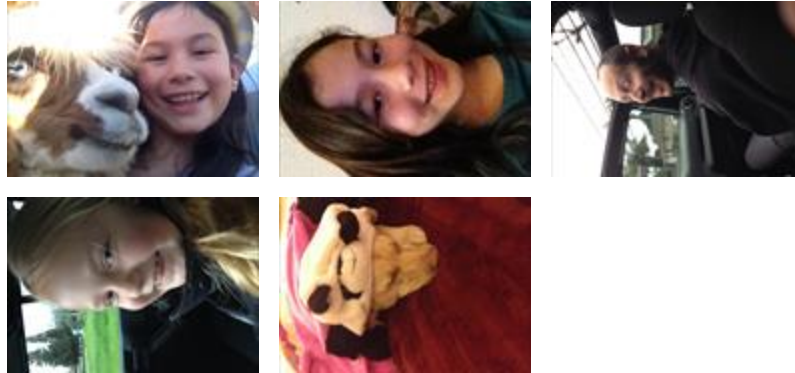

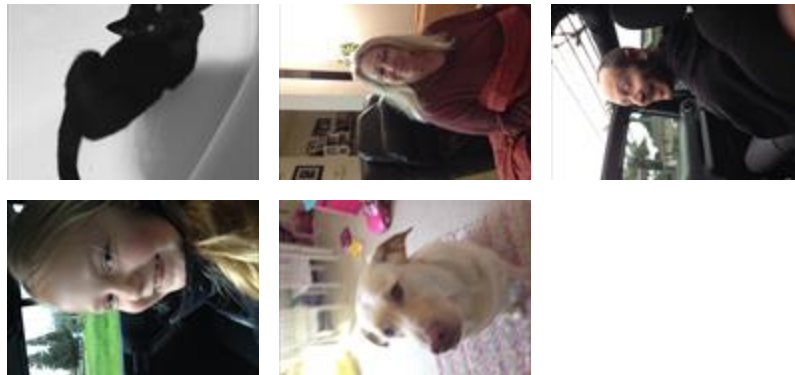

“ It is with profound sadness and a heavy heart that I am saying goodbye to my favourite and only brother Jerry who shared my life for 66 years. Jerry was our mother's favourite child with white blond hair and a sunny disposition. Her last words to me were "look after your brother" which I have tried to honour my entire life. The past five weeks were a difficult struggle in Jerry's journey. He was so fortunate to have been working at Mount Sinai Hospital on the day he had his heart attack. He was admitted to the CCU where his special family of friends could come to visit him daily. He knew that he had a serious situation and that open heart surgery was his only option that would offer him the chance to go to California to visit his son Alex and his cherished granddaughters.

Jerry was hopeful going into his surgery even though he was scared, and we said goodbye to each other on the phone early that morning. He underwent 10 hours of very extensive surgery with major complications on May 4th and was considered to be critically ill. 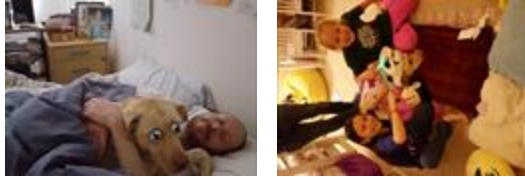
