Gilles Arseneault (May 1955- Dec 2024)

The family of Gilles Arseneault is sad to announce his departure from this realm on Saturday December 14, 2024 at the age of 69.

Born in Dalhousie New Brunswick, he was the son of Léon Arseneault and Annie Bella Arseneault (née Lapointe). He is mourned by his brother Jacques Arseneault (Toronto), his sisters Lorraine Bean (Toronto), Estelle Arseneault (Gatineau) and Monique Arseneault (Moncton), and several nephews and nieces. His youngest sister Sylvie has gone before him, earlier this year.

Remembered as a feisty advocate for his classmates at the then new high school Aux Quatre Vents in Dalhousie, Gilles went on to study political science at Université de Moncton, with a particular fondness for revolutionary ideas in recent history, and later completed his apprenticeship as a carpenter. He worked extensively in high rise construction, then, in association with his friend Brian Milani, as a demolition expert and revaluing of architectural remnants, notably in colourful and imaginative animal representations. His artistic bent became a great source of comfort and satisfaction during the long years that followed the massive injury to the head that led to his death. He was a frequent visitor at the ROM and produced great numbers of works on paper, plywood and canvass.

In a moment of confidence, he told of having had a choice to live or die at the time of his injury, and had chosen to survive for a bonus of years, since the

adventure of dying was something that was sure to come. And it has come, and we weep to see him go while rejoicing in the end of his suffering.
