Obituary for Gisèle (Ghiselaine) Boulay

Gisèle Boulay, of Niagara Falls and formerly of Sturgeon Falls passed away peacefully with her family by her side at the age of 90 at Scarborough Grace Hospital in Scarborough, Ontario on October 19, 2019.

She would plan her route, mark her stops and would bargain down the prices all while having a good chat with everyone. She was a sharp dresser and loved matching purses and hats to her outfits. She did not have a mean bone in her body but you would not have wanted to get between her and the last piece of pickerel at a family get together! May she rest in eternal peace.

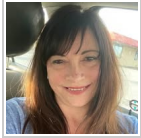
