As a family man, he coached youth soccer to give back to the community. He loved life, using humour to connect with people, ensuring everyone who met Gunti remembered him. Dad loved music. German music was usually playing somewhere in the house, louder at Christmas, giving his kids fond memories of “Johnny McRoy”.

Guenter could fix anything, often breaking something in the process which he

always laughed off before fixing it, whether it be electronics, home repairs, or cars. He cherished his model train and stamp collections, keeping meticulous care of both. Gunti enjoyed playing cribbage with his kids, whether they cheated together on him or he double skunked them. Dad never lost his love for watching Bundesliga matches and was happy to see Canada make it to the 2024 Fifa World Cup. He often shouted encouragement or bad calls from his Lazyboy. Gunti always let his children know how proud he was of them and was always there to help, there wasn't anything he wouldn't do for his kids.
