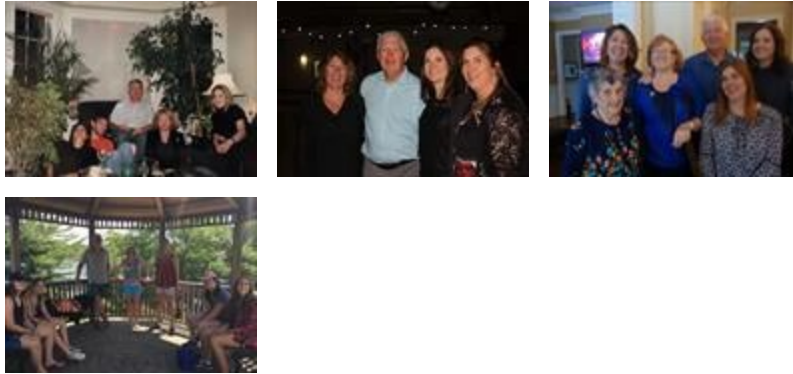
He will be profoundly missed by Islay, his family, friends, and the many lives he touched.
