Jana Fajer died in her home on October 9, 2024 in Toronto, Ontario, Canada. She won a long hard battle against breast cancer and fully recovered, however several years later succumbed to a heart attack at the age of 61, assumed to be caused because of her history of high blood pressure and high cholesterol. She was born in Bojnice, Slovakia and moved to Canada mid-life.

Jana was a very kind woman. She loved her children; A son and daughter, more than anything in the world and constantly put their welfare and comfort over her own time and time again. And she is loved by her entire family also including her three brothers and her parents who she talked with every single week up until her death, who will all miss her dearly.
