The family would like to send heartfelt thanks to the staff at Michael Garron Hospital for the comfort and care they offered John during his final days.

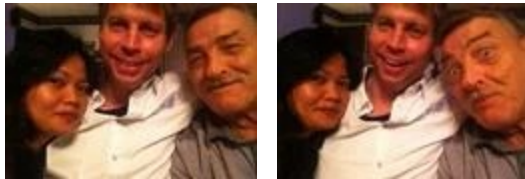
Cremation has taken place. A celebration of John's life will be held at a later date.

“ Toronto sun Tuesday, August 14, 1979

In a funeral home in a little town called Sunderland yesterday, one hero said his final farewell to another.

John Barnett of Scarborough paid his last respects to Owen Jones 16 who died in a farm well filled with fumes last Friday after helping push his unconscious brother Lionel Jones 14 to the surface.

Barnett 35 risked his own life to descend headfirst into the well in a brave but futile attempt to save Owen, who collapse from the fumes and plunged into the water after Lynal was saved. Minutes before Barnett and Don Titley, 17 his sister-in-law's boyfriend helped pull Lynal to the surface by a rope while Owen pushed.

Barnett who succeeded in getting Owen's body to the surface, barely made it out himself after being overcome with by the fumes. At the funeral home yesterday Lynal shook the hands and thank the man who had helped save his life.

Then Loren Jones, Owen's father, Approached Barnett with tears in his eyes to thank the stranger who helped saved his son and Barnett a father himself came close to breaking down.

My only wish is that we could have saved Owen as well as Lynal Barnett said. They should give the boy a Metal- to his memory I will never forget him holding Lynal in his arms in the bottom of that well and yelling to us, get my bother out!

Barnett and his family did not accompany the Jones family to the cemetery.

"My wife got pretty emotional and I got pretty emotional and said we just have to leave" he said.

OPP officers who investigated the case have recommended Barnett an Award for his bravery, something Barnett a truck driver for post office says he nether needs or wants...

"I wasn't the only one who helped he said "Don was pulling on the ropes and so was my son John jr and my brother-in-law Tony Bayda and Doreen my sister in law and my wife Sonia where the ones who went to call for help.

The family was heading up to visit their father in Balsom lake when Mario Flume 52 Owen of the property near Kirkfield where the

tragedy occurred while the Jones family youths where helping clean out the well, Mario raced out in front of the car on the highway begging them for help.
