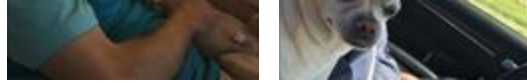
You also were nice enough to invite me to some amazing work events. I got to sit in a corporate box suite at the Bell Center and join you on a great road trip to Halifax.

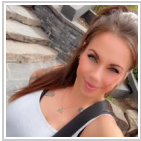

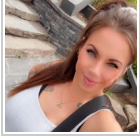

We will carry on your memory forever in our hearts and I will keep you alive within our home.

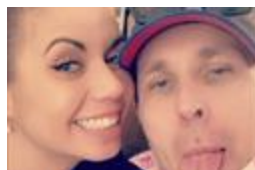
