John Alexander Reynolds passed away peacefully in Guildwood on June 20th, 2023 following a long term illness. A 4th generation Canadian, he was born in Toronto, Ontario on Feb 10th, 1937 and is survived by his wife of 62 years, Helina, his children, Karen and Thomas, two granddaughters; Hayley and Paige and his sisters – Linda Deacon and Eleanor Ramsey.

John was employed by Bell Telephone (Bell Canada) from 1955 to 1990. He started off climbing telephone poles doing repairs & installations, worked on special assignments such as converting lines from Avalon in NFLD in 1964 and retired as a Manager of BIS Services.
