On September 24th, 2023, Kosta Ktami passed away peacefully in his sleep at his home. He was 89 years old.

Kosta was born in Jerusalem, Palestine in 1934. He lived there with his parents and brother Wahid until they moved to Amman in 1947. Kosta met his wife Louisa in West Germany where they later married. The couple emigrated with their first child to Toronto, Canada. There they built a new life and raised a family.

Kosta worked for SPAR Aerospace Industries as a key member of the team that developed and built the Canadarm, used on the Space Shuttle and currently used on the International Space Station (ISS) and spacecraft systems.

Kosta is survived by his wife Louisa, his four children: Mary, Michael, Omar, and Mark, his eight grandchildren: Tanya, Laura, Sabrina, Jessica, Michael, Alexandria, Karalena, and Cristiana, and three great grandchildren: William, Aleksandar, and Teodor.

Kosta was an avid reader of historical, political, and biographical novels. Regularly shared his love of antiques and their origins with his wife and children and was an extremely passionate chef and baker.
