Lucia and I became very close when she and another friend came to my aid during a time of struggle. She basically changed my life when she got a hold of me and kept me going by teaching me how to meditate. She continued to teach me and practice with me, while giving me guidance and advice.

Every morning she came to my classroom to say hello and compliment me or encourage me.

If she couldn't say anything positive, she said nothing. She just smiled at you.

Lucia went about her day working diligently and quickly. She did not waste her time on idle talk. She managed to do all her work efficiently while staying relaxed. I was surprised and wondered how she managed to keep her mind calm all the time.

She treated her students with gentleness and sincere love. She found the positive aspects and worked with them.

But my friendship with Lucia deepened when she started inviting me to walk with her during the summer break.

We would walk in the park near her house. She would say, "One more time?" Three times. We walked and talked about our children. She never bragged but I could see how much she loved George and how proud she was of her sons and their wives. She loved being a grandmother.

During one of our walks she said:" When you miss your children, instead of crying, imagine the bright light of God, and send it to them ."
I still do that now .

When we got home from the walk, she would give me orange juice in a wine glass. I loved that.

Then we would meditate together for a long time. Then some lunch. I felt so good.

Some days we would pick up her grandson. Then she made lunch for him and helped him eat , with so much gentleness and devotion.

Lucia hired people with special needs to clean her house . She did it for them. This is the kind of person she was!

She always found the good in people. She could build you up and make you happy.

In the last few years, she really loved going places with George, whether trips or exercise. George was the love of her life and her best friend.

Lucia, you are everything I want to be. I will always love you and carry your smile with me. I feel you now ,watching over me. When I'm feeling sad I will listen to your voice of sweet reassurance. When I'm in doubt I will ask myself:" What would Lucia do?"

Lucia died a peaceful death, with her family around her and George praying for her by her bedside . She died the same way she lived.
