She was special to her two great-grandchildren Caitlin and Bryce (Jackie & Kevin), fondly remembered to all the family as “Nan”. Margaret spent a couple of her early married years in Hollywood CA working part time as both a model and as an extra in several Hollywood films. On returning to Canada, she was an integral part of the birth of the first all-terrain vehicle, “The Jigger”, invented by her husband Jack. Later, striking out on her own with Marcia, Margaret became a pioneer for women as a business-to-business sales professional, introducing Chargex (later became VISA) to businesses in the GTA, and went on to become a Sales Manager for the team. Having meticulously saved her hard earned money, she went on her own to buy a “Panhandler” gift store franchise in Burlington. After running the most successful store in the franchise history, she left to start her own gift store, “Featherstone’s” as the only independent to launch in the new, high end “Oakville Place Mall”. In her years since retirement she became an active member of “The May Court Club of Oakville”, a volunteer women’s organization, giving service and raising funds for the community, where she rose to become President in 1998 and 99.
