



Mrs. Mary Agnes Murray (nee Eyre)

On Wednesday, January 25, 2012 in her 88th year our Mum passed away at Queens Garden Nursing Home in Hamilton, Ontario. Predeceased by beloved husband Frank Murray, parents Margaret and Vernon Eyre, sister Peggy and brother John of England. Survived by brother Frank and sisters-in-law Pat Eyre and Marjorie Murray in Ireland. Loving mother of Lois Murray, Rachel Moore (Kerry), Desmond Murray (Marylou) and Frances Murray. Much loved grandmother of Roxane Eden, Heather Murray, Caroline Sutton and Michelle Murray.

Born March 4, 1924, Mary was among the children evacuated from London during World War II. After the war, she joined the British civil service and worked in India where she met Frank Murray. They married in 1951 in London, England and had two children, Lois and Rachel. The family immigrated to Toronto in 1956 where Desmond and Frances were born. In 1971, the family moved to Australia where they resided for two years and where Lois and Rachel still make their home. Mary worked at Canadian Tire in Oakville for 15 years. In 1990 after many years of part-time study, Mary achieved her Bachelor of Arts degree in Anthropology from McMaster University, graduating summa cum laude. Mary and Frank retired to Barrington, Nova Scotia in 1990 where they spent many happy years. The family wishes to thank the staff of Queens Garden for their compassionate care of Mum during her final years. Cremation has taken place. Mary's remains will be interred with Frank's in Barrington, Nova Scotia, a place they loved, and a graveside service will be
