



## Mr. Matti Severi Rampanen

Matti Severi Rampanen passed unexpectedly on October 2nd, 2015 at St. Michael's Hospital in Toronto, ON at the age of 66 years old.

Born in the small town of Veteli, Finland, on August 7th, 1949 to Severi and Eila Rampanen, Matti emigrated to Canada at an early age. Though he had a period of personal struggle, he attempted to right his wrongs and make amends. A long-standing fan of the Maple Leafs and Blue Jays, he could be heard shouting "YEAA!" each time his team would score, and he would argue with the referees through the TV.

He is survived by his siblings: Joni, Liisa, and Tero; his children: Shauna, Maija, and Erik, his grandchildren: Demal, Shaunae, Kyauna, Cadence, Scarlett and Violette; as well as his great-granddaughter: Jenesis.

He will be greatly missed by all who knew and loved him.

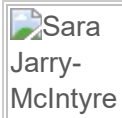

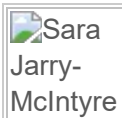

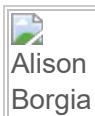
