May was pre-deceased by her adored and adoring husband William in 1981 and is survived by her grateful and loving children Nancy and Daniel (Annemarie); welcomed-loving-and-smiled-upon grandchildren Michelle (Bram), Jayson (Shandell), Lisa, Gemma and Al; cherished great-grand-daughters Courtney, Emily, Sophie and brothers William and James (Joan). She was the 5th daughter of Marie and Duncan and surrogate Mother to her 3 younger brothers in Winnipeg during and following the depression; loyally joining the RCAF preceding the outbreak of WWII, also playing a mean basketball defence for the Air Force Team (and eventually working successfully as a co-founder/ partner (in the creation of and book-keeping foundation) of a travel agency in Cambridge, ON (Galt). She remained fiercely proud of her islands’ heritage – The Isle of Skye, Prince Edward Island and Manitoulin Island and was forever absorbed in and treasuring “my books”!
