



## Mr. Paul Vincent Conley

It is with great sadness that we announce the passing of Paul Vincent Conley, Sr. at the age of 84, on June 16, 2016. He was predeceased by his first wife, Doris (nee Radburn) in 1995. He leaves behind his loving wife, Mely, his daughter, Jody, his sons, James (and Monique), Paul (and Maria Grace) and his stepdaughter, Jacqueline (and Rally), as well as his beloved grandchildren, Jessica, Stephanie, Aidan, Mathieu, Jacob, Patrick, Julia, Justin, Griffin, Tristan, Jaral and his great-grandson, London. He was predeceased by his sister Carol and will be sadly missed by his sisters, Frances, Mary, Jane, and their families.

Paul wished everyone to know that he had a good life and was happy. He was born in Medford, Massachusetts, on September 3, 1931 and never lost his New England roots with regular visits to his summer home on Peaks Island, Maine. He graduated from Cheverus High School in Portland, Maine and enlisted in the US Marine Corps in 1949, just prior to the start of the Korean war; graduated from University of Ottawa in 1956; spent the summer of 1956 documenting weather in the Arctic; worked for over 40 years in the wire and cable industry before starting his own company; coached the Agincourt Eagles during the 70s; and travelled the world.

However what he valued most was being the patriarch of an extended family.
