LYNCH, PAUL ALLAN passed away peacefully at Michael Garron Hospital with family by his side on August 5, 2019. Paul was born on December 19, 1952 in Toronto, Ontario.

Predeceased by his father, George Allan Foster Lynch of Antigua and Barbuda, his mother, Mildred Catherine Lynch (nee James) of Halifax, Nova Scotia, and sister, Edris Lynch of Antigua and Barbuda.
