I first met Ray in the early 80's. He was a good friend of my brother Alain. Ray and I connected immediately. We both liked progressive rock (as opposed to milder music like Harmonium), we drank the same beer, competed at Othello (which he taught me) and had extensive discussions on the meaning of life, the existence of deities, alternate realities and parallel universes.

Ray was a deep thinker, a great debater, an excellent writer (He asked me to read his first script entitled "Jadis, un homme" which was brilliant). His intelligence and sense of humor knew no boundaries. He introduced me to jazz/prog fusion which we listened to while debating until the early hours of the morning.

I moved to the Toronto area a few years later and Ray came and stayed with me for a few months while he looked to establish himself there, which he ultimately did. He gave me his entire record collection (except for his Renaissance albums he held so dearly) at one point because he didn't want them anymore and the medium had changed to Compact Disks. His love of prog and prog/ fusion remained and was shared with many of his friends over the years. He and I lost touch when I moved back to this area yet every time I look at one of the LP's he gave me, hear about those artists and listen to their work, I think about Ray and how much I miss him. I never told him that...I wish I had.

If there are alternate realities and parallel universes (which he and I concluded were strong possibilities), I know they are all the better because Ray is in each and every one of them. He left ours too early. Miss you Ray.
