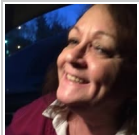

*This past couple of weeks has been full of tears and memories.*

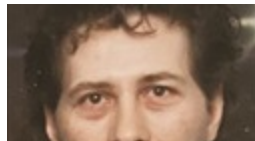

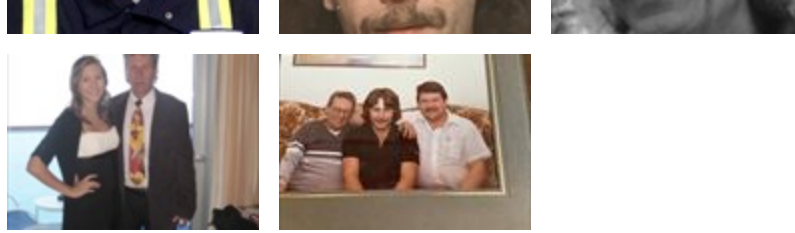
*Reggie, you are very special to me, yes, sometimes you were a pain in the butt but mostly a loving brother!*
