Reverend Richard, (Dick) John Green of Oshawa, Ontario, in his 87th year, passed away on Friday, October 2nd, 2020 of complications due to dementia. Dick was born in Cornwall, ON on July 1st, 1934. After high school, he attended and graduated from Eastern Pentecostal Bible College, Peterborough, ON.

Dick was married to Wanda, Vera Anna Green (nee: Stevenson) of Kinburn, ON on October 1st, 1955, and they were married 60 years.

Richard, (Dick), with Wanda by his side, pastored churches in Goderich, Orangeville, Wallaceburg, London, Barrie, Brantford and Oshawa, ON. After leaving pastoral ministry Dick served as assistant to the District Superintendent of Eastern Ontario & Nunavut District of the Pentecostal Assemblies of Canada for seven years caring for Developing Assemblies and Ethic Churches.

Dick is survived by his children: Steve Green (Debra) of Griffith, ON, Debbie Edwards (John) of Fergus, ON Mark Green (Jennifer) of Oshawa.
