Ricky (Rick) Allan Heldt, of Toronto, Canada, passed away on November 6, 2017, at his home.

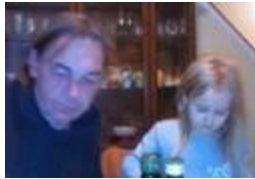
