



## Robert (Bob) Wayne Metcalfe

Robert (Bob) Wayne Metcalfe, 76, of Toronto, died on Sunday, March 17th, 2024, after a brief illness at St. Michael's Hospital.

He was born on October 26, 1947, to Margaret and George Metcalfe in Sarnia, Ontario.

Bob graduated with honours from S.C.I.T.S, then went on to attend the University of Waterloo, receiving a Bachelor of Science Degree, Earth Sciences. At Queen's University, Kingston, he completed a Master's Degree in Geology.

Bob was always very proud of the work he accomplished. He was a Sectional and Resident Geologist for Welkom Gold Mining, and Freddie's Consolidated Mines, in South Africa (1972-1975). Bob worked at SMDC in La Ronge, Saskatchewan doing geological surveys and exploration for uranium (1977-1979), at the Alberta Energy Company as a uranium supervisor (1979-1983), and at Kenneco Exploration (Toronto) as a senior geologist (1984-1986). He started his own geological consulting firm, Metcalfe and Associates, in 1986 in Oakville, Ontario and he worked as an instructor at University of Toronto and then Ryerson University until retirement.

Bob was married to Lynn Metcalfe (Leaver) from 1969 until 1999. He is survived by sons Ben (Dawn) and Patrick, grandson Jacob, good friend Chris, sister Judy Clendenning, brother Jim (Maxine), sister-in-law Elsie and nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by brother Reg, brother-in-law Jerrie Clendenning, and sister-in-law Dorothy.
