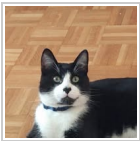

Then in high school she became my own personal bodyguard against a bully. She had no fear, and wouldn't back down.

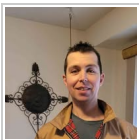
I always loved having Robin over for get-togethers and "Festivus". Her dry wit and sarcasm always made me chuckle.
