Passed away suddenly on April 5, 2016 in his 92nd year.

Sheldon, born in British Guiana in 1924, attended St. Stanislaus College before working at the Cane Grove, Adelphi and Rose Hall sugar estates owned by Booker Bros. During WW II, Sheldon served in the BG Home Guard. In 1955 he immigrated to Canada and retrained as an electrician while working at Sally Shops in Montreal. Sheldon joined Northern Electric in 1957 as an installer, retiring in 1989 and was a member of the Telephone Pioneers of America, Macdonald-Cartier Chapter No. 55.

When younger, Sheldon enjoyed cricket, tennis and football and was an avid photographer, developing photos in his own darkroom. He loved dancing at parties and singing.

In Canada Sheldon traded in his motorcycle for a bicycle, riding the waterfront trails of Toronto. He also enjoyed walking through the bush and sailing at Ashbridge's Bay.

Pre-deceased by his wife Zena Edmonds, and siblings Sheila, Monica, Marjorie and Gordon. Sheldon is survived by his children Godric, Haward, and Monica (Mike) and grandchildren Alexandra (Michael) and Garrett (Mackenzie), brothers and sister William, Dennis, Dorothy and Nolan.

A graveside service will take place at the Resthaven Memorial Gardens at a later date.
