dedication and support.

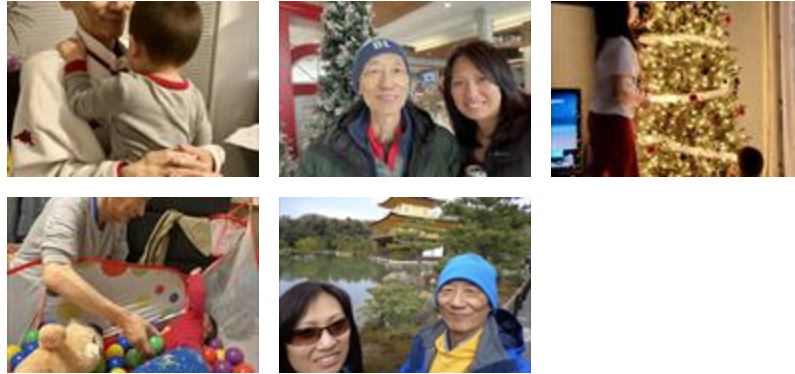
