sketches how technology seemingly caught up years later.

A son, a father, a brother and a friend, Tony was predeceased by his loving parents Lloyd (2009), Cassie (2013) and sister Jeannette (1987).

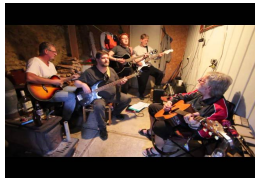
